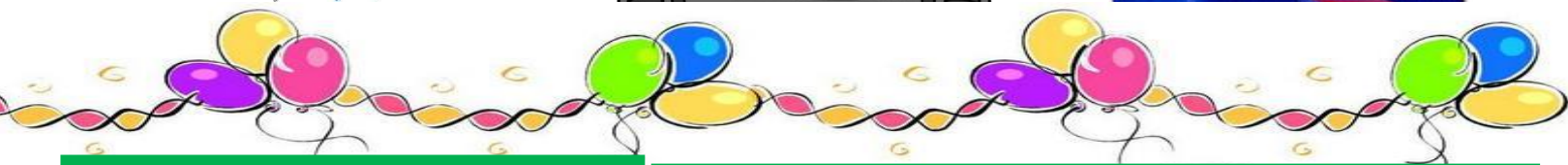

Again, we thank you for your cooperation in being good global citizens!

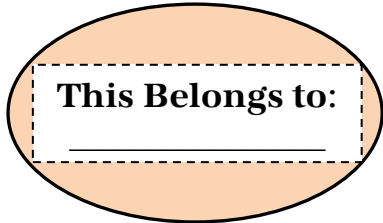
