Select four of the following books to read to your child over the summer. Student need to complete four book reports based on the books read aloud to them.

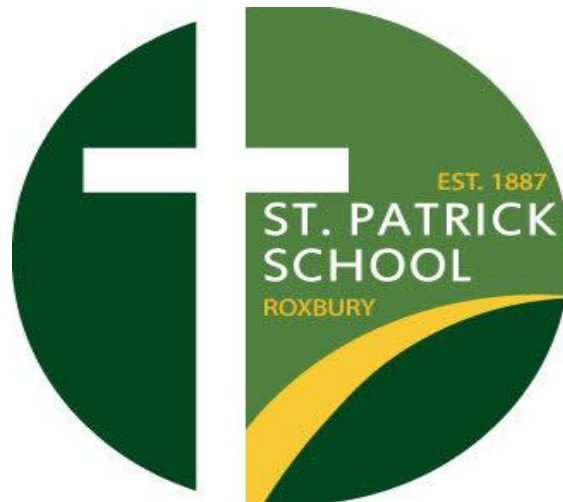
